NEW YORK UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF LAW, 1950 ANNUAL SURVEY OF AMERICAN LAW. New York: Prentice-Hall, Inc., 1951. Pp. x, 915. \$10.00.

This is the ninth volume in the series started by New York University in 1942. Not a mere digest but a careful analysis and critical comment on decisions, legislation and legal writing during the year, it makes very interesting reading and provides an excellent means for keeping abreast with developments in all fields of the law. Approximately half of the book is devoted to public law and half to private and adjective law; a short section on Legal Philosophy, History and Reform is at the end. There are approximately 50 articles and the subdivision is sufficiently minute to make it possible to find quickly any particular subject. There are a Table of Cases and a Topical Index. The book is valuable both for reference purposes and for general reading.
